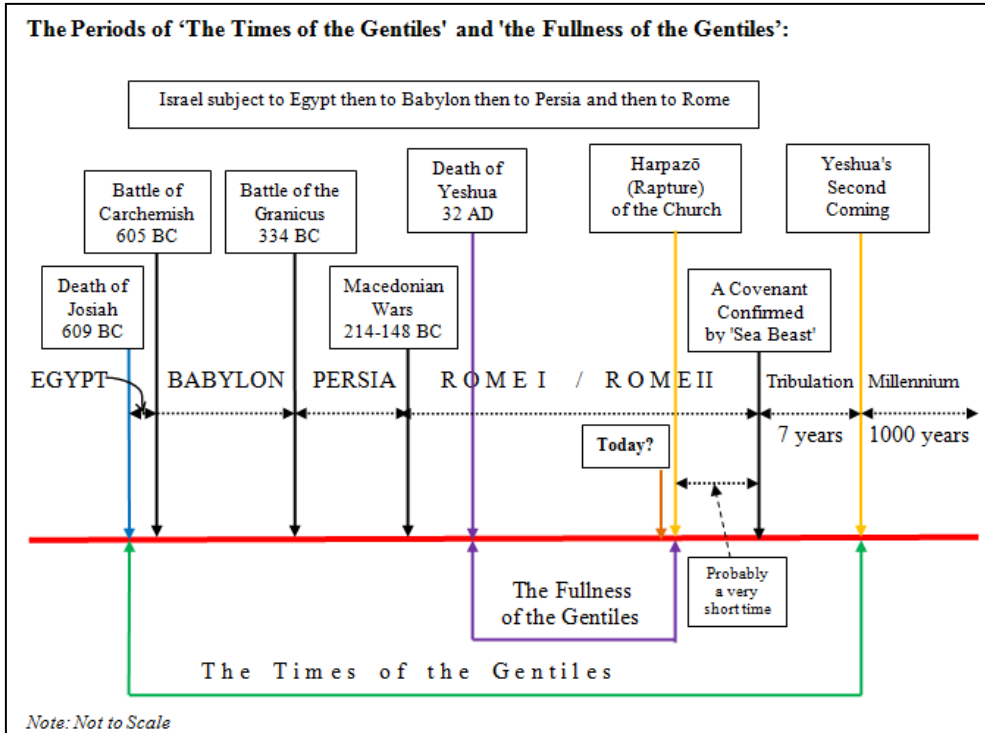
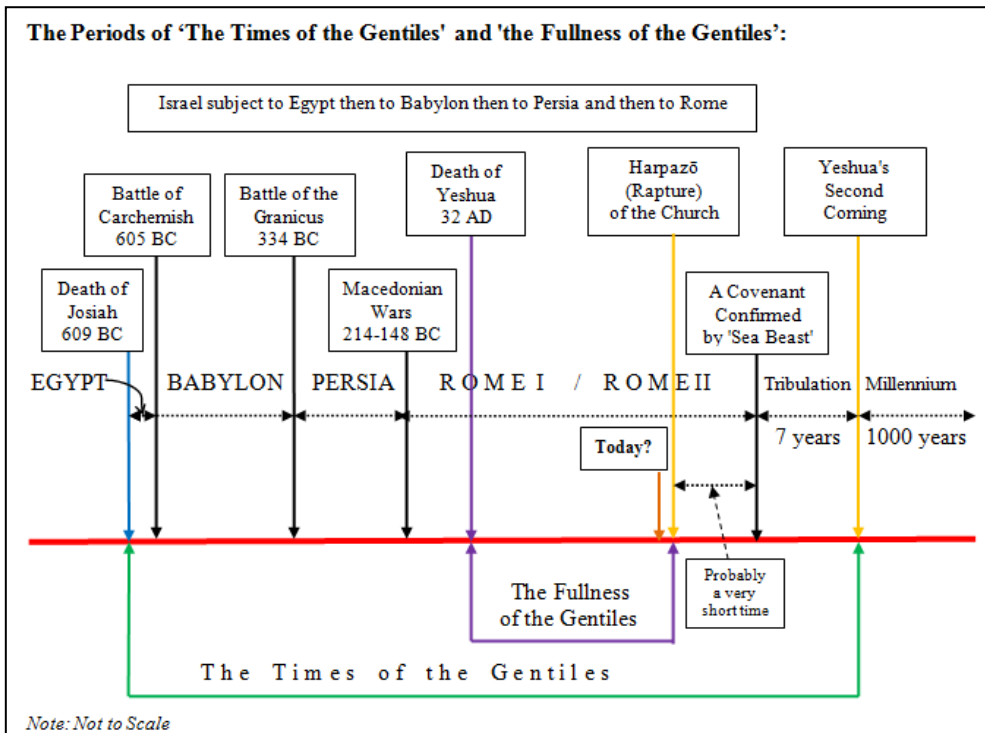

Pictorial of The Times and Fullness of the Gentiles

The Times of the Gentiles - as named by Jesus (Luke 21: 24)

Start Point: Death of Josiah in 609BC when Judah came under the rule of Pharaoh Necco of Egypt and later of Nebuchadnezzar (605BC).

Judgement of Judah under Manasseh (*2 Kings 21: 9-15*), deferred by the Lord under godly Josiah (*2 Kings: 22: 15-22*), was initiated at Josiah's death (*2 Kings 23:26-27*) - This was also start date for Judah's 70 years of Servitude (*Jeremiah 25: 8-12*)

End Point: The 'End of the War and Desolations' (*Daniel 9: 26-27*) when domination of Israel and Jerusalem by the gentiles is brought to an end at Yeshua's second coming
The final trampling of Jerusalem will be in the time of 'the Beast from the Sea' and the 'Beast from the Earth' - see Revelation 13

The Fullness of the Gentiles - as named by Paul (*Romans 11: 25*)

Start Point: 32AD - the death of Messiah Yeshua and (50 days later) the coming of the Holy Spirit which began 'the Church Age'

Israel's national rejection (through its leaders) of Jesus meant the gospel came to the gentiles (*Romans 11: 32*) - but God has not abandoned His people the Jews - see *Isaiah 59: 20-21; Ezekiel 36: 24-27; Jeremiah 31: 31-34; Zechariah 13: 1; Romans 11: 26-31*

End Point: The *Harpazō*, the 'catching away' - the rapture of the church. After which begins the Tribulation (7 years) and the end of the 'blindness of Israel when she calls upon her Messiah, Yeshua' - see *Hosea 5: 15; Matthew 23: 39; Zechariah 12:10, 13: 1*
